Launch of Youth Wiki

The <u>Youth Wiki</u>, Europe's online encyclopedia of national youth policies, was launched by the Education.



Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA) and Directorate-General Education, Youth, Sport and Culture, in Brussels on 12 December 2017.

This web-based platform provides a comprehensive database on national structures, policies and actions supporting young people. Its objectives are to promote European cooperation in the field of youth and to support evidence-based decision making.

Structure of the European Education Systems 2017/18

The <u>latest edition</u> of this annual publication provides an at-a-glance overview of 43 education systems, covering all 38 countries participating in the EU's <u>Erasmus+</u> programme. For each system, a schematic diagram shows possible student pathways from pre-school, through primary and secondary education and higher education.



This is a useful resource to accompany the reading of comparative education reports.

Compulsory Education in Europe

The <u>2017/18</u> edition of this publication looks at the duration of compulsory education/training in Europe. It highlights starting and leaving ages and distinguishes between full-time and part-time compulsory education/training.

Education and Training Monitor

The European Commission has issued a new edition of its annual publication on education and training in the EU. *Education and Training Monitor 2017* focuses on the theme of inequality in education and the role of education in building a fairer society. It provides cross-national analysis, along with 28 individual country reports.
